

General Guide Lines for Whitehall Camp & Conference Center Lease Holders

1. It is essential that you sign your lease, mark the back of lease according to your plan, send your payment with your signed lease by April 1st of the lease year or select one of the discounted dates.
2. If you have a Cottage or Mobile home with Year Round Water you must pay the Year Round Access fee.
3. For other areas with seasonal water remember it is turned off mid-October and back on by end of April. You are responsible for winterizing and maintaining lines past the shut off valve.
4. Your lease includes normal house hold waste removal. We are not able to handle yard waste (leaves, limbs), building materials, appliances, furniture, in our dumpsters. If you are doing remodeling work such as roof work you need to rent a dumpster for the project. If you have appliances or furniture you need to make special arrangements for its removal or remove it yourself.
5. There is to be NO Leaf burning on any leased property. If you rake your leaves into piles next to road we will remove them at no charge the month of November up until Thanksgiving and the first 2 weeks of May. All other times you will be responsible to haul them to the compose pile on the other side of the RV Overflow area or make arrangements for removal through the office for a fee. Remember no leaves in the dumpsters.
6. All pets are to be confined to inside private residence only. You are permitted to walk your pet on a leash to pet walk areas only and you must pick up after your pet. There are to be no pets in any public buildings or places such as the playground. Pets that are disturbing neighbors will have to be removed from leased property.
