Summer Youth Camps

What to Bring:

- **Bedding:** Sleeping bag or sheets, blankets, & pillow (twin size bed)
- **Personal Care:** Bath towels, washcloths, toothbrush, toothpaste, comb, soap, deodorant, & other personal care items
- **Clothing:** Casual clothing is best -
Shorts, T-shirts, jeans, and a sweatshirt. Don't forget to bring your swimsuit and SNEAKERS (for activities) and sandals/flip flops (for at the lake)! Please see dress code below.
- **Extras:** Flashlight, notebook/journal, pencil/pen, water bottle, sunscreen, sunglasses, bug spray
- **Spending money** for in the Camp Store if you wish. (Snacks, slushies, ice cream, apparel for sale each evening)
 - This money will be deposited into the child's camp store account at check-in or can be preloaded ahead of time online.
- **DON'T FORGET YOUR BIBLE!**

What not to bring:

- Video game players, matches, fireworks, tobacco products, alcohol, or illegal drugs.
- We also discourage bringing cell phones, ipads, or ipods or other electronics -
If a camper chooses to bring any of these, it must be left in their bunk during the day. If a camper is caught using their cell phone at any other time, or caught with other electronics, they will be confiscated for the duration of the week. If any use of a cell phone is deemed inappropriate by camp staff, they will be confiscated. PLEASE NOTE: Whitehall Camp is not liable for any damages, or lost or stolen electronics that are brought to camp.

Dress Code:

Our desire at Whitehall Camp is to honor God in all that we do, including the way we dress and how we present ourselves. Therefore, we have a dress code that encourages modesty. If the dress code is not followed campers will be asked to change and if the dress code is repeatedly ignored, campers will be asked to leave.

What to Wear:

- Pants
- T-shirts
- Tank tops (MUST have straps 2 inches wide)
- Shorts (MUST be no shorter than 4 inches above the knee)
- Shoes or sandals are to be worn at all times, except in the lake, on the beach, on the sand volleyball court, or in the shower. Please bring extra shoes. Don't forget your SNEAKERS as they are required for activities.
- One piece bathing suit (if a 2 piece is brought to camp, you will be required to wear a dark T-shirt over it).

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What NOT to Wear:

- Spaghetti strap, tube tops, or strapless shirts
- Cut off t-shirts
- Shirts with the armholes cut out low to show ones side (muscle shirts)
- Shorts with writing on the back
- Shirts that show one's midriff or are revealing
- Shorts that are too short or have holes in them
